Other activities include canoeing, archery, waterfront lake swimming, wellness programs and activities including evening relaxation, sports including volleyball, soccer and softball, and, of course, capture the flag! Skilled volunteers with various talents will also be visiting throughout the summer with additional programs.

Chapel is held every morning and every evening, with Liturgy celebrated once per week.

This season, Hieromonk Michael (Dahulich), the Bishop-Elect of the Diocese of New York and New Jersey, will also be visiting camp each week.
